CONFIRMATION AND CATECHISM INSTRUCTION:

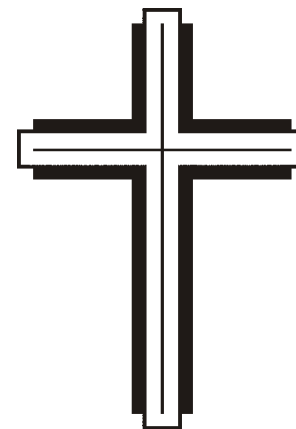
