6. *international ladies – loneliness*

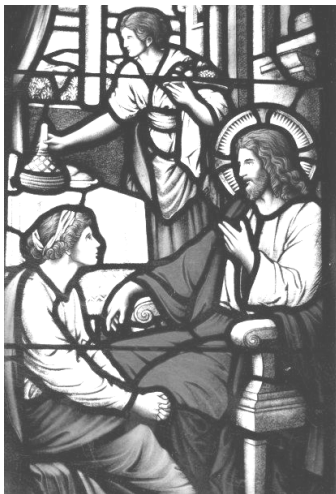
Quarterly Gatherings
