Audio recordings of our worship services are available at Zion on the hall table by the Mueckler library. They are also at CTK in the entrance area. Please listen to God's message and share it with others.

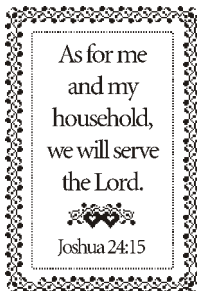

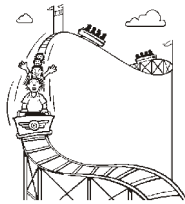
