- 4) To maintain a Christian atmosphere incorporating appropriate learning resources, including Christian songs, videos, and Bible stories.

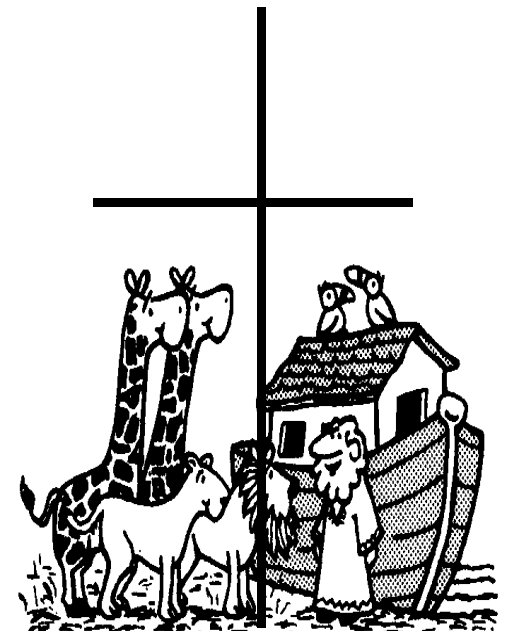

OUR HISTORY

Zion Lutheran Preschool began operation in January of 1971. We are open to preschool children of all families of any denomination, creed, race or ethnic group. We welcome your child to our program.

LOCATION

We are located in a spacious, well-equipped, cheerful room of Zion Lutheran Church at 3401 E. River Rd., Mt. Pleasant (989) 772-1516. It is located on the north side of River Road between Old Mission and Crawford. You may come directly into the preschool through the fenced play area or in the main entrance and through the building.

CURRICULUM

There are learning experiences in dramatic play, nature and science and math, art, music and language. There will be a balance of active and quiet play, individual and group learning and directed and free choice activities.

THE STAFF

Each preschool class is staffed with a qualified director/teacher and one or more associate teachers.

PARENTS

Parents are an integral part of the program and are always welcome. For the safety of the children, the outside doors are locked, so that unknown people can't wander in. There are opportunities for parental involvement in classroom activities. Parents may choose to be involved in fundraisers, field trips, classroom parties or other activities.

FINANCIAL AID

Financial aid is available to assist in the payment of tuition. If this would help enable you to send your child to Zion, please fill out a Financial Aid Application.

TRANSPORTATION

Parents are responsible for transporting students to and from Zion Lutheran Preschool. You may arrange for transportation through day care providers, car pool, or the ICTC transportation system.

ADMINISTRATION

Zion is a nonprofit organization under the supervision of Zion Lutheran Church and Zion's Board of Christian Education. The school is licensed by the State of Michigan.

ENROLLMENT AND SCHEDULES

To be enrolled, a child must be at least three or four years of age on or before December 1 of that school year and must be fully toilet trained. (This includes no pull-ups and being able to take care of one's own bathroom needs).

Afternoon drop-off: 12:00 - 12:15 p.m.

Afternoon pick-up: 3:15 - 3:30 p.m.

TUITION

Three-year-old class: \$66.00 monthly

Four-year-old class: \$88.00 monthly

CALENDAR

Classes operate between Labor Day and Memorial Day and closely follow the Mount Pleasant public schools calendar.
